Bill & Kate Isles



Bill and Kate are back by popular demand. This acoustic singer/songwriter duo are based in Duluth, Minnesota. Using a wide variety of musical styles, their performances carry audiences through a broad landscape of experiences from metaphorical worlds to small town family stories and to zany comedy. Their seventh album, "Still Beneath the Stars and Moon" won a Reader's Choice award for Best Album of 2011.

Bill Isles (Born and raised in Duluth, MN) performed his first show of original songs, after a twenty-five year hiatus, in February of 2000. Since that time, he has become one of the most well known singer/songwriters in the Minnesota acoustic scene and has been getting national and international attention. Bill's love of life has strong roots in his childhood, but his urgency to tell these stories comes from an experience in 1993 when, with just enough warning to drive himself to the hospital, he experienced a Sudden Cardiac Arrest. He arrived with just ten minutes to spare. After being defibrillated, and before the doctors had time to detect and open a blocked artery in his heart, he made a commitment to himself that, if he survived, he would begin to write again. Those paddles restarted more than just his heart...

Kate Isles (Born in Tecumseh, NE, raised in Rochester, MN) was a closet singer/songwriter when she came to a CD release concert for Bill's first CD, "Weightless" after hearing a public radio interview. She bought the CD and signed up on his e-mail list. ("Grounds for marriage!" quips Bill). Their song, "Public Radio (A True Story)" is a delightful duet that chronicles these beginnings. Kate released her first solo album, "From Home", in 2015.

Second Saturday Concert is presented by the Houston Folklore and Music Society, a nonprofit organization dedicated to the preservation of folklore and folk/acoustic music. Coffee, water, cookies and sandwiches are available for purchase. Tickets are sold at the door - adults \$18, students (with ID), senior citizens (65) \$14, and children under 12 free with adults. Take exit toward Mason Rd; after 0.2 mile

Merge onto FM 1093 West; after 0.4 mile

Turn left onto S. Mason Rd; after 0.3 mile

Turn left onto Lakemont Bend Ln; after 0.1 mile

Turn right onto Somerset Hill Ln; after 0.2 mile

Turn left onto Cape Cottage Ln; after 282 feet

Turn left onto Coleridge Ln

20403 Coleridge Ln is on the right in 0.1 mile


