The historical setting of this ballad is most likely either the <u>War of the Spanish Succession</u> (1701-1714) or the <u>Seven Years War</u> (1756-1763). High Germany refers to the mountainous, Alpine southern part of Germany. Cecil Sharp collected a version of this song in 1906, and it was actually recorded on phonograph by Percy Grainger in 1908.

If you want to play along with Martin, Capo IV. Otherwise, move the capo up or down to suit your voice range.






