IN MEMORIAM: JOHN NOVA LOMAX

We lost an important member of the Houston music and literary community May 22. John Nova Lomax, son of our member John Lomax III and grandson of HFMS founder John Lomax Jr., was a prolific and gifted writer, focused mainly on the worlds of music, culture and sports around Houston and all of Texas. His work appeared in *Texas Monthly, Houstania, and Texas Highways*, and he wrote for twelve years for the *Houston Press*. John Nova was 53 years old.

John Nova and his family attended one of our pickin parties at Carolyn Davis's home on the banks of the Brazos along with his father, John Lomax III when the elder Lomax was in town for a program at Rice sponsored by the Houston Folk Music Archive at Fondren Library. John Nova was a friend of HFMS, and had mentioned us favorably in his writings. In a telephone conversation, my brother in law used the phrase "living in hope and dying despair". When I heard that, I told him he could be a major blues artist of Ponchatoula, LA. Alas, he does aspire to that. Fortunately (depending on your opinion), there is the *ChatGPT* app on openai.com and several other such systems available. So I ventured forth with a test run.

I asked for a blues song to be written in the style of Skip James [Nehemiah Curtis "Skip" James (June 9, 1902 – October 3, 1969)] based on the theme "living in hope and dying in despair". It put out 4 verses with a chorus and outgo. I have included a sample of the verses. I also ran test with adding verses to some songs that I like so that I would know how to sing along with them. You may have some fun with this if you have not already tried to do so.

Claude's Lament (an AI composition)

I woke up this morning, with a heavy hearted soul, Feelin' down and weary, like I'm stuck in a deep, dark hole. Livin' in hope, but dyin' in despair, Life's been unkind, don't seem fair.

CHORUS: Oh, I'm livin' in hope, but dyin' in despair,
Feelin' lost and broken, like life ain't playin' fair.
Tryin' to find my way, in this world so cold,
Livin' in hope, but the road's gettin' old.

I've seen my share of struggles, faced many a storm, Fought through the battles, tried to keep my form. But sometimes it feels like I'm runnin' on empty, Livin' in hope, but the pain is plenty.

OUTGO: So I'll keep on goin', with my eyes on the light, Livin' in hope, and holdin' on tight. For in the midst of darkness, a spark can still ignite, And with hope in my heart, I'll keep on fightin' the night.

GOODBYE FAIR LADIES

I first heard the Kingston Trio's spirited recording of this song in 1962 – the year I graduated from high school. I was already well on my way to being a hard-core folkie. Away Rio is a traditional capstan shanty – dating to the 1860s or before. The "Rio Grande" of this song is almost certainly not the river of southwestern North America, but rather the province Rio Grande do Sul of southern Brazil. You can hear a traditional rendering of the song here, or on the HFMS Audio Archive. Every version I have heard has different verses, or the lyrics in a different order.

Oh, Galveston town is no place for me! Away Rio! So I'll pack up me sea chest and go back to sea! And we're... **CHORUS**


We'll man the good capstan and run her around. Away Rio! We'll haul up the anchor from out in the sound. And we're... **CHORUS**




